

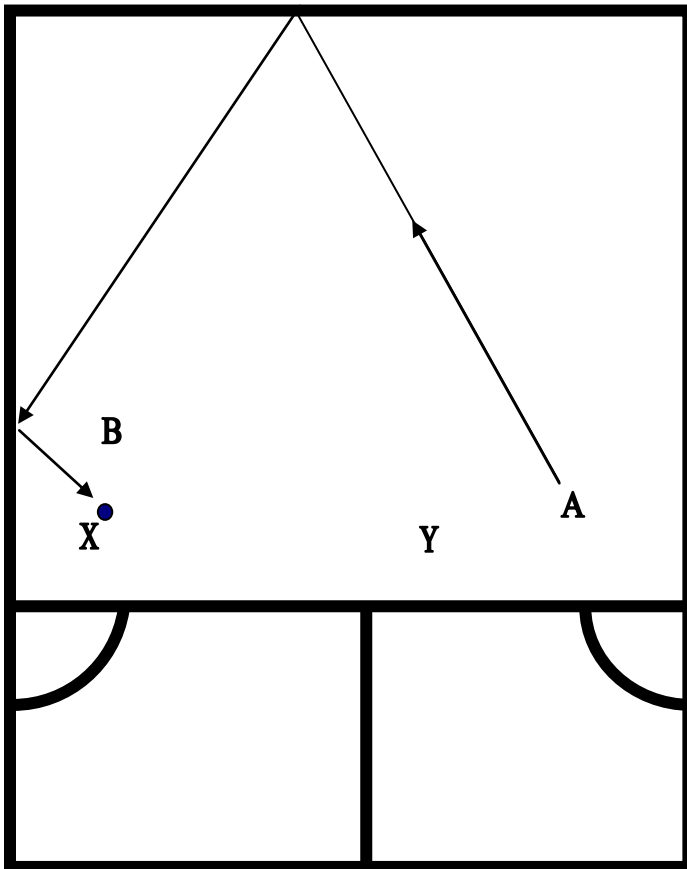
DOUBLES RULES



Tips for Players

HEY! WHAT HAPPENS WHEN YOU ARE REPEATEDLY IN THE WAY?

Player **A** hits a cross court and his partner **B** does not move clear and prevents player **X** from playing his shot.



A “**warning**” or two is given to player **B** to move clear. Subsequently if player **B** makes no effort to clear on the same situation, then it will be “**Point to X**”.

This thinking should apply to all repeated situations where a player continually makes no effort to move clear to allow his opponent to play his shot.
